

#### **Mode of Study:**

- The course is presented through a series of pre-recorded video lectures which allows each student to adapt their studies around their own work/life schedule.

#### **Diploma Licentiate Course**

#### **Duration:**

The course is designed for students to work at their own pace. The course is designed to be completed in three years. This enables students to join the live sessions on the specified dates.

80% attendance required in each year for live sessions.

In order to proceed to the next year, students need to pass the end of year examinations, which are scheduled in May & November each year.

If students are unable to sit for examinations in May or November, an invigilator can be arranged at an extra cost of @£50.00 per day.

We teach time tested, scientific, the non-confusing classical method, the "Simple Homoeopathy", founded on solid principles.

#### **Online Learning:**

Here at Allen College, we provide our students with a solid foundation in Classical Homoeopathy based on therapeutic principles as well as modern and practical concepts.

Excellent teaching and support from the College, alongside a strong commitment to your studies from you, will ensure your development into a competent and confident professional Homoeopath.

Allen College of Homoeopathy has welcomed students into the physical classroom for almost thirty years. However, times have changed greatly, particularly over the last few years. Due to these global shifts to online learning and with the aim of making the course more widely accessible we are now offering pre-recorded lectures.

These are available to view at your own convenience, from anywhere in the world.

Live lectures in which students can interact with the teachers, are an integral part of the course.

#### **Course Structure: Overview:**

This is a three-year part-time course, that will provide you with all the skills, knowledge and training you need to become a fully qualified, professional Homoeopath.

Learn how to implement Miasm in your prescription for an effective outcome.





#### Recorded Sessions (each session is six hours):

Each academic year consists of:

- 17 days of progressive core curriculum learning.
- Two days of cases recorded in Kolkata, India, demonstrating the depth and scope of Homoeopathy in serious pathology (approximately 12 hours).

Busy live clinics to regularly apply theory to the patient.

### Live Interactive Sessions (each session is six hours-10.00 to 17.00 hours with usual breaks- All U.K Time):

- Four winter seminars (approximately 24 hours). These day long interactive seminars are focussed on topics commonly seen in practice. There is focus on approach, management, and Materia Medica. e.g Anxiety and Insomnia, Grief, Eating Disorders.
- Two scheduled interactive live Q&A sessions are transmitted via video link in real time and during which, interaction with teachers and other students is encouraged to maximise this learning opportunity (approximately 12 hours).
- Clinical Experience- Six live clinics each year- An integral part of learning is clinical experience which is an opportunity to learn the practical prescribing with tutors and patient present: The clinic days have no less than 10 live patients per day. (Approximately 36 hours).

One day of live cases with patients present, from Kolkata,

So, in addition to the pre-recorded sessions; Thirteen live sessions per academic year (six clinics; one Clinical discussion; two Q&A sessions and four winter tutorials).

#### This totals almost 550 hours of learning material over three years.

Learn Materia Medica through comparison, groups and live application in our busy clinic seeing up to 10 cases per day.



#### **Graduation Criteria:**

- In order to graduate students must have passed all the relevant assessment procedures.
- Home Assignments at over 50% marks accumulated throughout.
- Examinations at over 40% marks.
- Total marks throughout the course are combined. There is 30% emphasis given to Home Assignments and 40% to Examinations.
- Live/Contact time lectures require 80% attendance.
- Adhered to the signed contract agreement throughout the course.
- The requisite number of supervised cases completed to the required standard.
  - **4 Chronic with 2 follow ups each**, if appropriate, 2 of which are observed by a supervisor and **2 Acute with 1 follow up.** Completed Case Comment sheets to be submitted for each case.
- The joint Supervisors report should indicate a readiness to practice.
- To have submitted a summary of their own Reflective Diary/letter written from the experiences in the Allen Clinic, Supervision and throughout the course.
- Committed to a professional practice and Continuing Professional Development.



- After graduation the graduate will be invited to use Dip. Hom.
   A.C.H.
- **Diploma in Homoeopathy [Allen College of Homoeopathy]** and will be invited to join the **Society of Homoeopath's** Register, dependent on conditions, please refer to the professional body for information.
- A proportion of the course is designed to facilitate personal development and fitness to practice is part of the overall assessment.
- If a tutor or lecturer recommends that to practice safely, further personal development is necessary, but the student has achieved all academic requirements; the board will consider how best to proceed in the best interests of the individual and the profession. In such case it may for example be recommended that the student may be requested to attend private sessions with an appropriate therapist until a level of practitioner suitability is reached. Such a decision is considered jointly, with the board, tutors and the student.
- Professional attitudes are implicit throughout the course and students are expected show evidence of personal development and adopt appropriate standards and ethics appropriate for the profession.

#### **Supervised Cases:**

In the second and third years student's are expected to take their own cases under the supervision of an experienced homoeopath. A minimum of four cases, but many students participate in and present many more.

Supervised cases prepare you for practice and build a portfolio of happy patients. Allen College provides support and encouragement to improve your confidence.

A list of Allen College recognised supervisors list will be provided.

#### **Further Details:**

- The academic year begins at your own convenience and your year of study of each module will conclude with an examination. A 40% pass mark is required in order to progress to the next module.
- Students are assessed through end of year exams, which are on a fixed day in May or November each year. If you need to schedule another date, there is a fee of £50 per day.
- Students are also encouraged to keep a reflective diary.





#### Fees:

Your investment will cover all lectures, lecture handout materials, tuition, seminars, clinical training, assessments, and certification. Medical science classes and clinical training are an integral part of the course, and subject to no additional fees.



#### **FAQ:**

## Q. Can I finish the course earlier than the recommended three years?

A. The course is designed to finish in 3 years. The required participation in the live sessions does not permit an early finish.

#### Q. What if I need to postpone a year?

A. You are required to notify us that you wish to take more time.

#### Q. What is the refund policy?

A. Fees are non-refundable.

Fees paid are for 12 months tuition from the date received by Allen College.

In some circumstances a student may defer, the fees can be applied for a maximum of 24 months only (12 months from the date of joining and a further 12 months if students' circumstances dictate to defer).

#### Q. How many hours a week will I have to study?

A. That is your choice- if you wish to complete the course in three years, you may need to study up to three hours per week, but it all depends on the individual.

### Q. What is the proportion of live attendance and recorded attendance?

A. The course is split into 17 days recorded sessions and 13 days of live interactive sessions, per year/module.

#### Q. How will I access the lecture material?

A. New students can register and, after payment, gain immediate access of the materials and the recorded sessions. These are sent via a link on an e.mail and should be requested in sequence. You will also be sent a link for the live sessions one or two days before the scheduled live session.
